YOUR CPD REQUIREMENTS FOR 2009/10

RULE 42 AND REGULATION 176 MANDATORY SEMINARS IN MARCH 2010

In New South Wales, regulation requires that all solicitors holding a current practising certificate must complete mandatory continuing legal education (Continuing Professional Development), unless they qualify for an exemption, by completing a course of education which satisfies the following requirements:

Complete 10 hours of qualifying training each CPD year, which runs from 1 April to 31 March (accredited specialists must also complete 10 hours at the specialist level) including the following special requirements:

RULE 42 REQUIREMENTS (new)

The course must include at least one (1) MCLE unit in each of the following fields:

- ▶ ethics and professional responsibility
- ▶ practice management and business skills
- ▶ professional skills

REGULATION 176 OF THE LEGAL PROFESSION REGULATION

Additionally, solicitors who are required to undertake mandatory MCLE/CPD must complete at least one (1) unit every three years of a course relating to the management of the practice of law which must cover:

- ▶ the principles of equal employment opportunity
- ▶ the law relating to discrimination and harassment
- ▶ occupational health and safety law
- ▶ employment law

Note : Topics which satisfy the mandatory requirement of Regulation 176 Legal Profession Regulation 2005 may also satisfy the Rule 42 requirement in ethics and professional responsibility or practice management and business skills, but not both.
